METHODOLOGY DETAILS

Online interviews fielded November 22-December 12, 2021
Margin of error +- 3.5 percentage points

For this statewide survey of Utah residents, address based sampling was used to randomly select households to receive survey invitations. Survey invitations were sent via postcards through USPS mail, and interviews were completed online. The survey was made available in both English and Spanish to increase accessibility.

Responses to this survey have been weighted to reflect the demographics of the statewide population of Utah residents according to the most recent available estimates from the US Census Bureau's American Community Survey, specifically in regards to age, gender, ethnicity, education, and household income.


